<u>Toledo</u>

The city in itself is the most characteristic example of Spanish civilization. It is like an inmense museum containing some of the most oustanding artistic treasures in Spain. Its old Gothic and Renaissance buildings and its narrow streets provide a vivid portrait of the city and its splendid past. At its heart one may find the works of a painter who epitomises the spirit of the city - El Greco. Today, Toledo is still the spiritual capital of Spain and has officially been declared a National Heritage Site. Suggested visits: the Cathedral, Santo Tomé Church, the Sinagogue, Tavera's Museum, the Alcázar, Saint John of the Kings and the craft manufacture of its well-known Damascene work.
