Developments

- Initial move:
 - a general legal agreement with the institution claiming their rights to the content
- Then:
 - a pre-supposed implicit past authors' intention of ensuring public access to their published results
 - in case of any reclaimed authors' objection, specific file subject to limited accessibility clause or entirely blocked



Status, 2012

Collection:

- Archive of journals through Y2K
- Current journal editions
- Books incl. monographs, Banach Center proceedings and collected works of
- The top members of the Polish Mathematical School



Structure

- Affiliation with the Virtual Library of Science (PL)
- Content module within *SyNaT*, the Polish integrated knowledge infrastructure (under development, full operational capacity, early 2013)

Heritage

Emergence of digital content:

- Conversions vs. digitally born
- Sequential vs. non-sequential forms

Legal limitations:

- legacy: non-existing legal agreements
(no digital and e- exploitation fields)
- the only practical approach:
based on implicit intention guess
- current status:
still possible to shape structurally and formally
